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Public Notice regarding undelivered Registration Certificates


U/S 19 (ii) of the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) Act, 1992, the Council issues Registration Certificate to those candidates who possess any of the RCI's approved qualification(s) in the field of Special Education & Disability Rehabilitation.

Candidate (s) desirous to register with the Council is required to submit their Online Application for Registration with the Council comprising of correct postal address i.e. permanent /temporary to enable the Council to dispatch the original certificate to the respective candidate(s).

Due to incorrect, incomplete or change of address, large number of Registration Certificates has been undelivered and returned to the Council by the Postal Department. Details of undelivered registration Certificates, name of the candidates, CRR No. , etc. are being displayed on the Council's website from time to time for information of all concerned.

Despite of Council's various efforts, some of the candidates have collected their certificates either in person or by submission of correct address. In absence of correct postal address, most of the registration certificates could not be delivered to the respective candidates. However, as per the records available with the Council, such candidates have been contacted through phone and these undelivered certificates have once again been sent to the concerned on their correct address through Speed Post.

Details of the such registration Certificate, candidate's name , their CRR No., date of dispatch have been displayed on the Council's website www.rehabcouncil.nic.in/writereaddata/UNDELIVERED%20CERT.PDF All concerned, are hereby advised to access the information from the website. In case of non -receipt of the certificate, candidates may send their request for dispatch of certificates on their latest address through e-mail .
